Family Day Care Grounds for Suspension of an Educators Name from Register

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Purpose & Scope

Lake Macquarie Family Day Care has a responsibility to protect the dignity, safety, and welfare of children in care and ensure children have opportunity to learn and develop in a stimulating environment with positive adult interactions.

Educators with Lake Macquarie Family Day Care must ensure education and care is provided in accordance with regulatory and legislative requirements.

Lake Macquarie Family Day Care needs to establish grounds for suspension of an educator's name from the Register of Educators to maintain care standards and deal with complaints about education and care provision fairly and equitably.

Process

Where an education and care service, provided by a registered educator, does not comply with The National Quality Framework, policies or procedures, the Nominated Supervisor, or delegate will recommend the Approved Provider suspend an educator's name from the Lake Macquarie Family Day Care Register of Educators, either:

- immediately when, in the professional judgement of the Nominated Supervisor, or delegate, the actions of an educator have placed a child in imminent physical, emotional or moral danger, or the educator has demonstrated intentional disregard for regulatory requirements, policies or procedures
- when an educator has not fulfilled, or refuses to fulfil, the requirements of an educator action plan developed in response to a complaint
- when an educator, in the professional judgement of the Nominated Supervisor, or delegate, has not demonstrated adequate change of practices, as a result of resolution of prior complaints
- when an educator, in the professional judgement of the Nominated Supervisor, or delegate has not demonstrated, or refuses to demonstrate, quality practice improvement in accordance with the requirements of The National Quality Framework

All action to review a complaint relating to education and care provision or to suspend an educator's name from the Register of Educators will be in accordance with Lake Macquarie Family Day Care Complaints Handling Procedure.

Term / Abbreviation	Definition
Approved Provider	Lake Macquarie City Council, for the operation of the approved service, Lake Macquarie Family Day Care
Nominated Supervisor or delegate	Authorised Supervisor of Lake Macquarie Family Day Care, Nominated Supervisor – responsible (along with the Approved Provider) for ensuring the scheme is following the Law and the Regulations, Certified Supervisor – a person with a supervisor certificate placed in day to day charge of an education and care service.
Educator	(a) a person actually involved in educating, minding or caring for children at his or her residence or venue and whose name appears on a current Lake Macquarie

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	Family Day Care Register of Educators (a primary educator); and (b) a person whose name appears on a current Lake Macquarie Family Day Care Register of Educators and who is engaged as a relief educator to educate, mind or care for children in the residence or venue of a primary educator	
	(c) a person whose name appears on a current Lake Macquarie Family Day Care Register of Educators and who is engaged as an educator assistant to educate, mind or care for children in the residence or venue of a primary educator for no more than 4 hours
