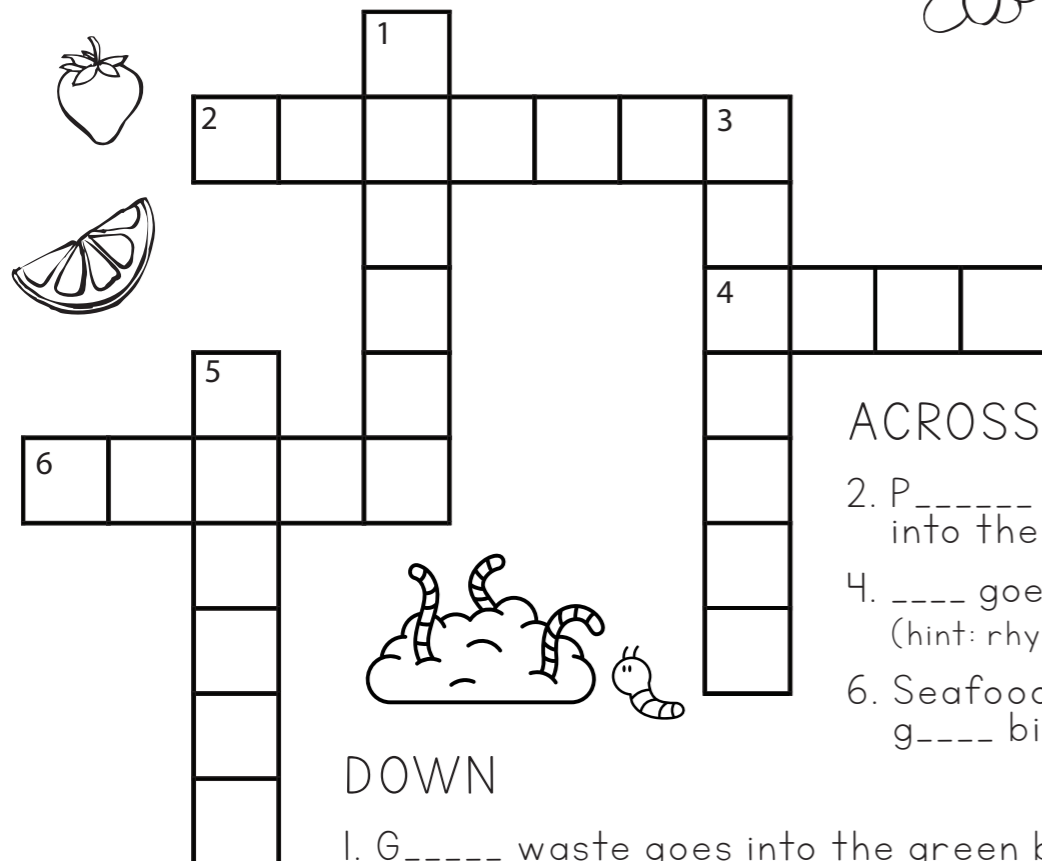
We all need to reduce the amount of waste we produce - there is no planet B.

What can I do at home?

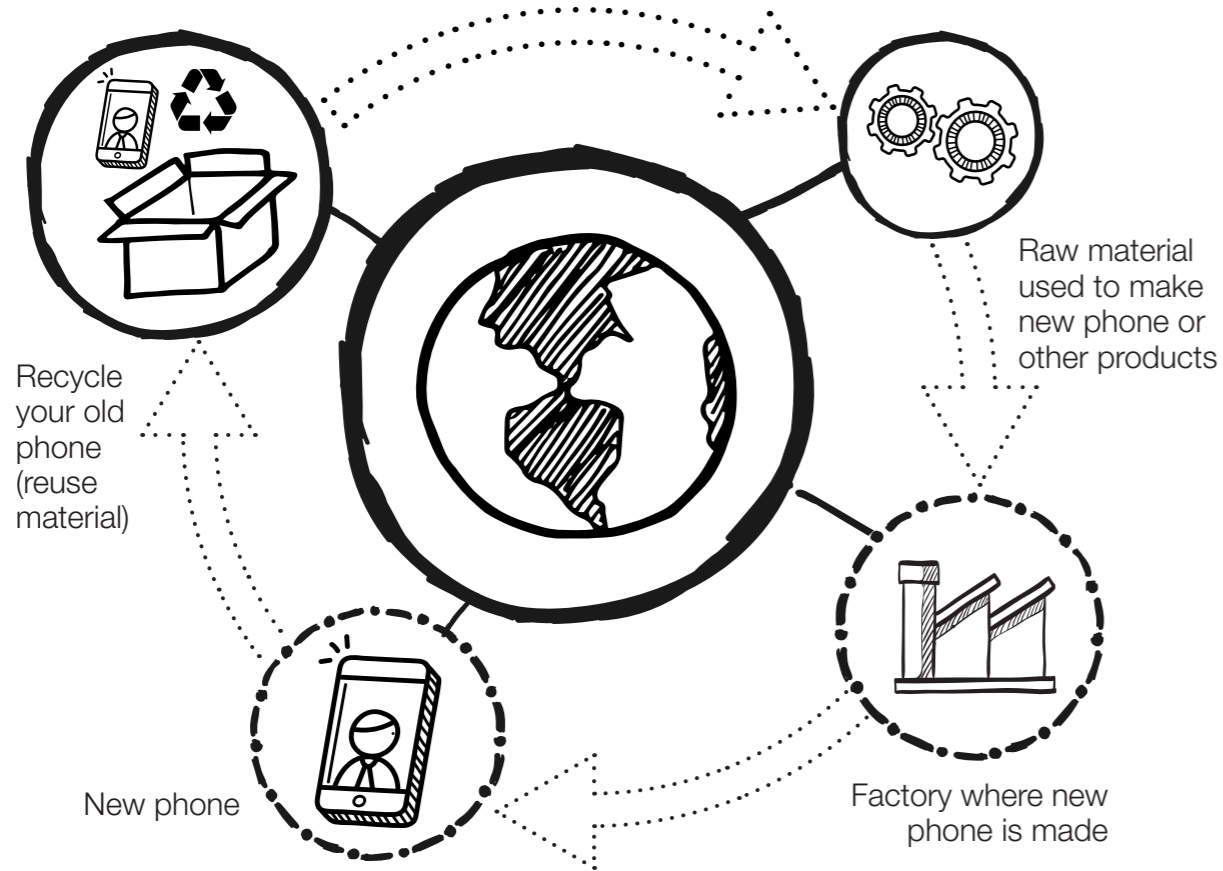


1. Check if something can be rehomed, sold or donated to a second hand shop.
